That the Chehalis kiver in New Westminster Water District appears suitable for the development of water power out the information available in that connection is not sufficient to enable any intending applicant to properly make application under the Water Act;

That it appears advisable in order to enable the suitability of the said chehalis giver to be investigated to reserve all the unrecorded water of the said river and its tributaries;

AND TO RECOMMEND:

THAT pursuant to the provisions of section 290 of the water Act, being chapter 271 of the nevised Statutes of British columbia, 1924, all the unrecorded water of chehalis niver and its tributaries in new Westminster water pistrict be reserved for power purpose and be reserved from being taken or used or acquired under the provisions of the said water Act.
