The Community is incorporated for the purpose of constructing, operating and maintaining works on Foursome Lake for storage as authorized under Conditional Water Licence 106448 and the supply of water from Foursome Lake to members' properties for irrigation and watering lawns/gardens under the following licences:

The members of the Community are the owners of the lands to which the aforesaid water licences are appurtenant. A membership shall pass upon conveyance or other disposition of the land.

The respective interests of the members of the Community shall be determined from the aforesaid diversion licences on Foursome Lake, as provided under Section 54 of the *Water Act*.

The Community is given all the powers set out in Section 52 of the *Water Act* in respect to storage and diversion works on Foursome Lake as authorized under the licences mentioned herein.

The provisions in Sections 52 to 61 of the *Water Act* govern the Community.

This Certificate of Incorporation replaces, in part, the Certificate of Incorporation issued to Foursome Lake Water Users' Community by the Deputy Comptroller of Water Rights on the 22nd day of November, 1981 and any amendments thereto.
