Recall and Re-Issue of the Certificate of Incorporation of the  
Lucille Mountain Water Users' Community

The Certificate of Incorporation of the Lucille Mountain Water Users' Community issued by the Deputy Comptroller of Water Rights on the 21st day of March, 1988, and any amendments thereto, are hereby recalled and the following issued in lieu thereof:

Whereas the holders of water licences share a common interest in either the diversion of water directly from Edand Creek or the rediversion of water from Edand Creek originally diverted from Martinson Creek, I hereby incorporate those licences into a water users' community as follows:


1. The name of the Water Users' Community shall be Lucille Mountain.
2. The Water Users' Community is incorporated for the purpose of maintaining and operating a water system to supply water for domestic and stock watering purposes to lands appurtenant to licences included within the membership.
3. The following licences, or any licences issued in substitution thereof, are included within the membership of the Water Users' Community:
