The Community is given all the powers set out in Section 52 of the *Water Act* in respect to storage works on Proctor Lake as authorized under Conditional Water Licence 118228 and to works used to release stored water into Greenhow and Hutley Creeks as authorized under the licences mentioned herein.

The members of the Community are the holders of the licences mentioned herein.

A membership shall pass with a licence upon conveyance or other disposition of the land to which the licence is appurtenant.

The provisions in Sections 52 to 61 of the *Water Act* govern the Community.

This Certificate of Incorporation replaces the Certificate of Incorporation issued by the Deputy Comptroller of Water Rights on the 24th day of November, 1986 and any amendments thereto.
