Recall and Re-Issue of the Certificate of Incorporation
of the
Tranquille Valley Water Users' Community

The Certificate of Incorporation of the Tranquille Valley Water Users' Community, issued by the Deputy Comptroller of Water Rights on the 18th day of October, 1978, is hereby recalled and the following issued in lieu thereof:

WHEREAS the holders of certain water licences share a common interest in the diversion and use of water from Cecil Spring in the Kamloops Water District, I hereby incorporate those licences into a water users' community as follows:

- 1) The name of the Water Users' Community shall be Tranquille Valley.
- 2) The Water Users' Community is incorporated for the purpose of operating and maintaining a water system for domestic supply from Cecil Spring, and in this respect is given all the powers set out in Section 52 of the *Water Act*.
- 3) The following licences, or any licences issued in substitution thereof, are included within the membership of the Water Users' Community:
